ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

INTERNATIONAL MOVEMENT FOR CHRIST (IMC)

1. Section 501(c)(3) Limitation

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, and other purposes permitted under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

2. Religious, Educational, Missionary, and Charitable Activities

In furtherance of its exempt purposes, the Corporation may advance the Christian faith and the Gospel of Jesus Christ; conduct and support evangelism, missions, worship, discipleship, theological education, ministry and leadership training; establish, operate, or support churches, ministries, seminaries, schools, training programs, and educational initiatives; provide charitable and humanitarian assistance and community development; and conduct such activities in the United States and internationally, provided that all activities further purposes described in Section 501(c)(3).

3. Private Inurement and Political Activity Restrictions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, members, or other private persons, except that the Corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make payments and distributions in furtherance of its exempt purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as permitted by Section 501(c)(3). The Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

4. Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

5. Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction exclusively for such exempt purposes.
